1. Protecting Intellectual Property:

We have established this policy to address potential copyright infringement and other intellectual property violations which may violate the law including the <u>Digital Millennium Copyright Act (DMCA)</u>.

2. Reporting Infringement:

If you believe that content available on our service infringes your intellectual property rights, you can submit a notice of infringement to DMCA@ideatek.com. Any notice must include at least the following:

- A. Identification of the copyrighted work: Provide a clear description of the copyrighted work you believe is being infringed.
- B. Identification of the infringing content: Specify the location of the infringing content on our service, including relevant URLs or screenshots
- C. Contact information: Include your name, address, email address, and phone number.
- D. Statement of good faith: State that you have a good faith belief that the use of the copyrighted material is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law.
- E. Signature: Electronically sign the notice.

3. Our Response:

Upon receiving a complaint notice of infringement, we will:

- A. Review the notice: We will promptly review the notice to determine if it complies with applicable legal requirements.
- B. Remove infringing content: If we determine that the content infringes your intellectual property rights, we will take steps to remove the content from our service to the extent provided by law.
- C. Notify the user: We will notify the user identified as the source of the content about removal and provide them with an opportunity to respond.

4. Repeat Infringers:

We reserve the right to terminate the accounts of users who are repeat infringers of intellectual property rights.

5. Procedure to counter notice of infringement:

If the notified-user believes that the Content that is either not infringing, or the user believes that it has the right to post and use such Content from the rights owner, the owner's agent, or pursuant to the law (including as a fair use), the notified-user must send a counter-notice containing the following information to Ideatek's Designated Agent listed below:

- F. Identification of the Content that has been removed or disabled, including a description of where the material in question appeared on the service before it was removed or disabled (e.g., it's precise URL);
- G. A statement, made under penalty of perjury, that the user has a good faith belief that the Content was removed as a result of a mistake or misidentification of the Content in question;
- H. User contact information, including full name, mailing address, telephone number, and email address;
- I. A statement consenting to the jurisdiction of the Federal Court for the judicial district in which the user address is located or, if the address is outside of the USA, for Wichita, Kansas United States Federal Court, and that notified-userf will accept service of process from the person who provided notification of the alleged infringement;
- J. Notified-users' electronic or physical signature.

If a counter-notice is received by IdeaTek's Designated Agent, we will send a copy of the counter-notice to the original complaining party – including your address, telephone number, and email address – and inform that party that we may cease disabling the Notified-users services. Unless the rights owner files an action seeking a court order against the user, Ideatek may consider the complaint invalid at our discretion.

Please note that under Section 512(f) of the DMCA, any person who knowingly misrepresents that Content or activity is infringing may be subject to liability for damages, including attorney's fees.
